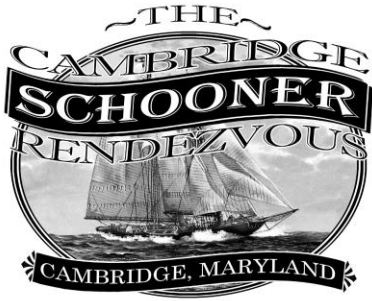
**Application Deadline:** Application must be submitted by **September 23, 2017**.

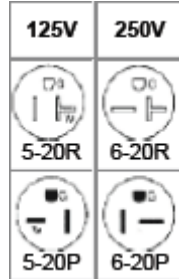

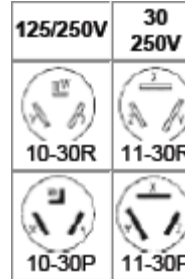
